ICAC Update: Commissioner Appointed

Federal Court Judge Bruce Lander has today been appointed as South Australia's first Independent Commissioner Against Corruption.

Justice Lander was admitted to the Supreme Court of South Australia in 1969 and commenced practising as a barrister in 1982. He was appointed Queen's Counsel in 1986 and then a Judge of the Supreme Court of South Australia in 1994. He has also served as an additional Judge of the Supreme Court of the ACT, Deputy President of the Administrative Appeals Tribunal and a Judge of the Supreme Court of Norfolk Island.

Justice Lander will formally commence his appointment later in the year, but as the Commissioner is now charged with the tasks of:

- establishing the ICAC;
- appointing a Deputy Commissioner;
- engaging staff to operate the Office for Public Integrity and ICAC;
- developing a system for the receipt of complaints by the OPI;
- preparing directions and guidelines governing reporting to the OPI; and
- establishing standard operating procedures into corruption investigations;

to enable commencement and full operation of the ICAC.
