There will be two components to this training. The first is a Contractor Awareness session and the second is a mock trial.

The Contractor Awareness section will focus on exploring the role of contractors to Council as public officers, and what this means both for contractors, and for council staff managing such contractors.

In addition, the *Work Health & Safety Act 2012* imposes numerous responsibilities and duties on both employers and those that may manage workplaces. This means that both the Council and Contractors have obligations to provide a safe and healthy work environment.

The mock trial will role play a workplace prosecution in a court environment and will present what some of the duties are, what can go wrong, and what happens when things do go wrong.

Contractors will have an opportunity to be actively involved in the trial, being called as witnesses, viewing and assessing evidence, and being asked to come to a conclusion as a jury.

Open and interactive discussion both during and at the end of the mock trial allows attendees to identify and discuss how the charges might have been avoided, and what could have been done better.

Contractors will gain a better understanding of the court system and process, and what can occur in a typical court proceeding.
