Seminar 3 Changes are Underway! Assessment Panels, Assessment Managers and transitional arrangements from 1 July 2017

KelleyJones Lawyers together with **Development Answers** is hosting a series of seminars on each stage of the Planning Reform process.

With the passage of the *Statutes Amendment (Planning, Development and Infrastructure) Act 2017* into law, a new Schedule 8 was inserted into the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016* to govern transitional arrangements.

1 July 2017 is the commencement date of the first of the transitional provisions which will affect councils. Specifically, councils will be required to appoint new Assessment Panels and an Assessment Manager and these appointees will be required to comply with requirements of the PDI Act.

This seminar will cover, in detail, the transitional arrangements and what requirements must be met by councils to achieve compliance from 1 July 2017, as well as future transitional provisions which will affect Assessment Panels and Assessment Managers.
